### In Memoriam

Lavon Frank  
May 4, 1925 - September 25, 2007

Loving wife of Ridge Frank, mother of Richard, mother-in-law of Lynn, and grandmother of Christopher and Jonathan, Lavon Frank passed away in Winston-Salem September 25, 2007, after suffering a massive heart attack September 19.

Lavon was an active member of NAME and a charter member of Forsyth Miniature Enthusiasts in Winston-Salem. She accompanied daughter-in-law Lynn to state days, houseparties, NAME conventions, Back to College Weekend in Virginia, to Fun Days, and was a regular exhibitor in the Enchanted Village at the Southern Christmas Show. Some of her work was done with husband Ridge. She preferred to furnish her miniatures with things she had made herself rather than things she had bought. Among her other hobbies was knitting, which she also reduced to 1" scale -- sweaters, scarves, caps, etc., beautifully made on piano wires.

Lavon had an off-beat sense of humor and was known for her spontaneous and unexpected "zingers" or slips of the tongue -- after which she might put her hand over her mouth and say, "I can't believe I said that!" She was fun to be with, upbeat, and talented. We will miss her, and we share with her family in their loss.
